“**Sfe. Ambassadors**” opens up the opportunities for you!

Sfe. Ambassadors are to be students who are currently studying in school/home-school/college, etc and between the age group, 8-30 years.

Ambassadors will be required to do some tasks every month which may include writing articles, increasing awareness about somethings, making differences, organizing a small event, etc. One thing is sure, No Money expenditure will be involved both by the ambassador or Sfe. (we aim to do money-less but effective projects).

For example, it's the month of June. The Ambassador's task might be to increase the awareness of World Environment Day's theme in their school or college. He/She is open to use the opportunity well and creatively. Maybe an article can be given in their newsletters, or maybe a video or poster can be made or A Flashmob or a small event or a competition, etc. One more thing, only Easily Manageable tasks will be given and will not be affecting your studies badly. So, you can strictly do it during your free times.

- **Duties of Ambassadors**

1. Be a role model and share Sfe. Values with his/her peers and people in the community.
2. Be an ambassador for Sfe. By encouraging more students to be a part of Students For The Earth.
3. Try to complete the task given every month and send the report back to us.
4. Tasks will be based on Sfe. Values of Environmental Protection, Community Service and Arts and Skill Development.
5. Events can be organized by the student as an Sfe. Ambassador. (Sfe. Is not responsible for obtaining any permissions, etc if necessary from local bodies or governments. The ambassador should obtain necessary permissions. Sfe. Is also not responsible for any untoward incident that happens during the event.)
(Events organized will be completely the responsibility of the organizer and not Sfe.)
6. No money expenditure need to be spent by the ambassador. Ambassadors are required to do events with zero budgets or can get a sponsor if needed. No money can be taken from participants. Sfe. Will also not be providing any financial assistance.
7. Be an active participant in Sfe. Programmes and campaigns (either on-site or online)

Note: Ambassadors can do the tasks as per their convenience without affecting the studies. In case of exams, etc, ambassadors can notify us so that they can do the same on a later date.

Benefits

- On completion, all ambassadors will get a Certificate of completion and also recommendation letter (Both will be send via email to reduce carbon emissions)
- Ambassadors can ask for Certificates on successful organization of each event as an Sfe. Ambassador.
- Be an ambassador of a globally renowned and respected Youth organization
- Get mentorship

Being an Sfe. Ambassador adds to your CV and list of achievements too. Do not miss this amazing opportunity.

The term for an ambassador will be 1 year and following which he/she can continue if interested.

Application Guidelines

Applications should be sent as a .pdf of not more than 5MB containing all the following details:-

- Name , Age, DOB, Name of institution, Country, Country of residence, Nationality
- Contact details: Email, Phone number (with country code)
- Answer the following questions:-
 - 1) Why do you want to be a Sfe. Ambassador? (100 words max)
 - 2) What are the 3 main things you want to do as a Sfe. Ambassador? (100 words max)
 - 3) How will you make a change differently being a Sfe. Ambassador? (100 words max)
 - 4) List of your achievements and Leadership positions you have held.
 - 5) Any activities you have volunteered in or organized related to environment protection, community service, etc
- (Any supporting evidences regarding your achievements, leadership positions and volunteering may be attached along with the application, but must not exceed 5 MB)
